October 13	3-5 PM	CoC Board approves Special CoC Consolidated Application, including Unsheltered Homelessness Plan.
October 18		Special NOFO Consolidated Application submitted to HUD. HUD will initiate project contracts. Note that conditional award funding is typically based on the submitted Final Prioritized List of local projects; however, actual awards and award amounts are determined by HUD.
